No. 254—SE(S)/1S-26/2010 (Part III).—23rd March, 2017. — In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 17, *read* with section 8 and clause (d) of sub-section (2) section 17, of the West Bengal School Service Commission Act, 1997 (West Ben. Act IV of 1997), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the West Bengal School Service Commission (Selection for appointment to the posts of Headmaster/Headmistress in Secondary or Higher Secondary and Junior High Schools) Rules, 2016, published with this Department notification No.1 114-S(S)/1S-26/2010 (Pt. III), dated the 21st September, 2016, published in *Kolkata Gazette, Extraordinary*, Part I, dated the 21st September, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):—
